Day 1

Night in Buenos Aires

Reception at Ezeiza International Airport and private transfer to Hotel



Buenos Aires is an elegant and the busiest city in South America which represents the Argentine essence. In spite of its modern constructions and dynamic activity, it has managed to preserve old traditions and charming corners. Visitors are fascinated by its environment, the individuality of each of its neighbourhoods, the cordiality of its people, and its wide selection of cultural and commercial opportunities. Buenos Aires, surrounded by Argentina's splendid countryside, is the great cosmopolitan doorway to South America.

Day 2

Night in Buenos Aires

Breakfast at Hotel - Golf Day in "San Andrés Golf Club" - with pull carts / caddies

It is the **oldest course** in Argentina, designed by Mungo Park in 1907, and takes its name from Scotland's St Andrew's. It is one of the best well-known courses because of its tradition and also its difficulties. With its extension of 6472 yards, it has a frightening rough even for the most skilful golfers. In this club the Abierto de la República Open Championship has been played most times. And the master Robert De Vicenzo gained in the Open on two occasions

This golf course was designed by the "American Golf Course Design", who also design the Four Seasons of Carmelo, Uruguay, Brasil, Chile and Panama. Estancias del Pilar Golf has 18 holes, with 7000 yards, par 72. It characterizes for having a beautiful design combined with high-quality greens. It is an attractive and varied course, a challenge for the players.

Day 5

Night in Buenos Aires

Breakfast at Hotel - Golf Round at **"Olivos Golf Club" (Number 1 in Argentina)**

Considered the best golf course in Argentina and one of the best in South America. Olivos Golf Club is a course of 27 holes in an extension with important unleveling, beautiful trees and greens of excellent quality and design. Founded in 1926 and designed by Luther Koontz. It has hosted the Argentine Open, the Argentinian Masters, in which some of the best European and American players participated. Olivos Golf Club hosted the "Golf World Cup on 2010".



Day 6

Night in Iguazu

Breakfast at Hotel and - Private Excursion **Waterfalls "Argentinean Side" / Hotel pick up 10.00am**



The tour leaves from the hotel to visit the Argentinean side of the Iguazú Falls, 67.000 hectares long, located within Iguazú National Park, one of the first protected areas of America. They are made up of 275 falls thundering down from a 70 meter average height. In this section of the rainforest, a huge variety of ferns, orchids, begonias, birds and butterflies can be seen while walking plus the walking plus the diversity of native species this Park has to offer. We are on our way to Estación Central, where we will take a train to Estación Cataratas and/or Estación Garganta del Diablo. Another way of reaching the Cataratas Upper and Lower Circuits is through the pedestrian trail Sendero Verde, 600 mts long, which starts at the Visitor Center and ends in Estación Cataratas.

Waterfalls Nautical Excursion included !



With powerful boats, we shall bounce into the Lower Iguazu River Canyon and bordering the San Martín Island we shall reach the Tres Mosqueteros Fall. At this point we shall be able to see the falls of both the Argentine and Brazilian sides and the Garganta del Diablo. Finalizing this trip, we offer an unforgettable experience: baptism shower at the bottom of the San Martín waterfall, the hugest cascade any boat may endeavor. This excursion starts and concludes at the dock located in front of the San Martín Island.

Day 7

Night in Iguazu

Breakfast at Hotel Private Excursion **Waterfalls "Brazilian Side" / Hotel pick up 10.00hs**



If we are staying at a Hotel in Puerto Iguazú, we depart from the Hotel and cross The International Bridge 'Tancredo Neves' (Puente de la Fraternidad) that joins the cities of Puerto Iguazú (Argentina) and Foz do Iguazú (Brazil). Here, at the crossing of borders, we have to go through the Customs at both sides of the bridge. As we get to the 'Visitor

Center' we have to enter the Gates individually to check the loading capacity of the Park. We immediately get into the buses that tour along within the park and take us to the 1200 trail over the 'Iguazú River'. At this point, we get a panoramic view of the Argentinean falls, ideal to take pictures. As we go on, we can see 'Cañon del Río Iguazú', Salto Rivadavia and Tres Mosqueteros. Towards the end of the tour we will get to Devil's Gorge lower viewpoint, 200 mts away. This beautiful scenery is enhanced by permanent rainbows. The tour ends at 'Salto Florian' where an elevator takes us to the bus parking. The other option is to walk the path and up the stairs to the meeting point. Return to the hotel.

Over the Iguazú Falls on a Helicopter Experience included !



On the Brazilian side, it is possible to have a unique experience by flying over the famous Iguazú Waterfalls at a prudent distance. These flights offer a majestic view of this geographical wonder of waters and falls. The sign located on the road invited us to a unique experience: flying over the Iguazú Waterfalls on a helicopter. This is one of the many flights leaving everyday from the Brazilian heliport. In a matter of minutes, they unveil the mystery of the falls from the air and they show how the Iguazú River continues its course until it empties into the Paraná River. Flying over the waterfalls on a helicopter is a tour like no other. It shows a unique sight of this place, which features the necessary magic to please the most demanding of mortals, even those who believe they have already seen everything.
